

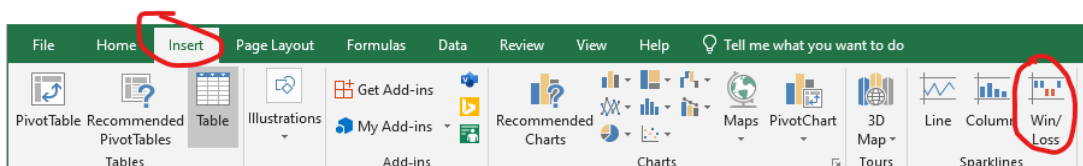
How to make an Excel Win-Loss Sparkline Chart

An Excel Win-Loss chart can be used as a visual for if numbers are either positive or negative. In this example, we will be doing 3 charts for three different football teams playing 7 games, to see whether they won or lost.

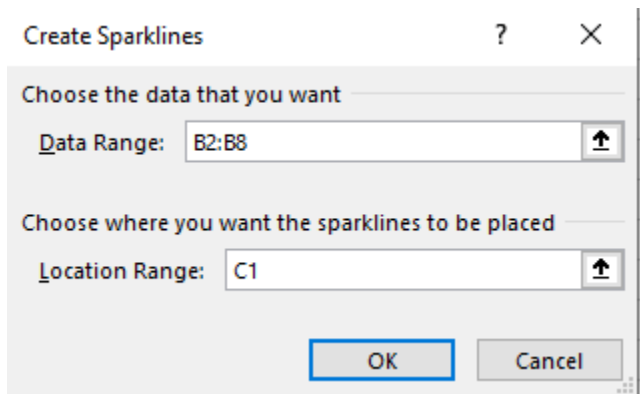
1. First, open up an Excel spreadsheet with the win-loss data you have. (Or you can make up data, like I have done below).

2. Highlight over Team Red's wins and losses (B2:B8). Go to the insert tab, and find the Win/Loss Sparkline.



- After clicking the Win/Loss button, a box should show up, and because you highlighted B2:B8. The data range section is already filled out.
- The location range is where the sparkline will show up. For the Red Team, you want it to the right of the Wins/Losses column. So, for location range, you can either type out C1, or just select the C1 cell.



- After selecting Ok, the sparkline should appear in C1. If you would like, you can expand the C column to make the sparkline slightly larger.
